

Refinishing Warranty

NW Refinishing warrants to the original end user that this product will be free from defects in its material and workmanship when used in a single shift (standard 8-hour day, 5 days per week) for the following warranty period:

5 Year Warranty Coverage: Paint applied to refinished cabinets, pedestals, and panel caps will not chip/peel

NW Refinishing does not warrant:

- · Defects due to product abuse, misuse, or negligence
- User modification or attachments to the product
- COM/COL materials
- · Failure resulting from normal wear and tear
- Products or parts not used, maintained, or installed in accordance with the company's installation and maintenance quidelines
- Products that are exposed to extreme environmental conditions such as water damage or fire and/or have been subject to improper storage
- · Minor irregularities of color in textiles, color-fastness, matching colors, grains, or textures of covering materials.

NW Refinishing will, at its option, repair or replace with a comparable product, without charge to the original purchaser, only defective products or parts reported as defective during the warranty period. If requested by NW Refinishing, the original purchaser must return the part or product with freight or other shipping charges prepaid. Pre-approved labor and service costs are covered under this warranty.

There are no other warranties, expressed or implied, other than those specifically described, including without limitation any implied warranty or merchantability or of fitness for a particular purpose. We will not be responsible for incidental or consequential damages.

Under no circumstances will NW Refinishing be liable for injuries or damages arising from use of the product.

This warranty shall be effective from the applicable time period beginning from the date of purchase as shown on original purchaser's original receipt or other proof of purchase.

If your product fails during normal use within the applicable warranty period, please contact NW Refinishing with a description of the issue, together with the invoice or purchase order of the product.
